What God says about you:

- I am not ever forgotten. 'Can a mother forget her nursing child? Can she feel no love for the child she has borne? But even if that were possible, I would not forget you! See, I have written your name on the palms of my hands.' Isaiah 49:15-16
- I am set apart. 'I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart and appointed you as my prophet to the nations.' <u>Jeremiah 1:5</u>
- I am God's possession. 'But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.' 1 Peter 2:9
- I am cherished by God. 'The Lord will not abandon his people, because that would dishonor his great name. For it has pleased the Lord to make you his very own people.' 1 Samuel 12:22

- God knows my words. 'You know what I am going to say even before I say it, Lord.' Psalms 139:4
- I am surrounded by God. 'You go before me and follow me. You place your hand of blessing on my head.' <u>Psalms 139:5</u>
- I am a citizen of heaven. 'But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for him to return as our Savior.' Philippians 3:20

- I am new. 'This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!' 2 Corinthians 5:17
- I am God's masterpiece. 'For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.' Ephesians 2:10
- I am a part of the body of Christ. 'All of you together are Christ's body, and each of you is a part of it.' 1 Corinthians 12:27
- I am united with other believers. 'There is no longer Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male and female. For you are all one in Christ Jesus.' <u>Galatians 3:28</u>
- I am Jesus's friend. 'I no longer call you slaves, because a master doesn't confide in his slaves. Now you are my friends, since I have told you everything the Father told me.' John 15:15
- **Jesus lives inside me.** 'My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.' <u>Galatians 2:20</u>

• I am victorious. 'No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.' Romans 8:37

What God does for you:

- God ransomed me. 'But now, O Jacob, listen to the Lord who created you. O Israel, the one who formed you says, "Do not be afraid, for I have ransomed you. I have called you by name; you are mine. ' Isaiah 43:1
- God is working within me. 'Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power
 at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think.' <u>Ephesians</u>

- God is working for my good. 'And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.' Romans 8:28
- The Spirit guides me to truth. 'When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future.' John 16:13

'Commit yourself to instruction; listen carefully to words of knowledge.' <u>Proverbs 23:12</u> 'But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you.' <u>John 14:26</u> 'All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right.' 2 <u>Timothy 3:16</u>
- **To confess.** 'But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.' 1 John 1:9 'Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.' James 5:16
- **To praise.** 'Therefore, let us offer through Jesus a continual sacrifice of praise to God, proclaiming our allegiance to his name.' Hebrews 13:15
- To share the Good News of Jesus. 'And then he told them, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone.' <u>Mark 16:15</u> 'Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it.' <u>1 Peter 3:15</u>
- **To put my faith into action.** 'And I am praying that you will put into action the generosity that comes from your faith as you understand and experience all the good things we have in Christ.' Philemon 1:6
- **To worship.** 'Jesus replied, "The Scriptures say, 'You must worship the Lord your God and serve only him.'" Luke 4:8
- To ask for help. 'If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and he will give it to you.
 He will not rebuke you for asking.' <u>James 1:5</u> 'My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth!' <u>Psalms 121:2</u> 'Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you.' <u>Matthew 7:7</u>
